

# ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE CRIMINAL JUSTICE ONLINE

The Associate of Science in Criminal Justice degree prepares students for entry-level careers in justice and security fields and/or to pursue the Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice degree. Students completing the associate degree will have met all specific liberal arts requirements for the bachelor of science degree at Indiana Wesleyan University, in addition to acquiring a solid foundational knowledge of the field of criminal justice.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the Associate of Science in Criminal Justice Program:

- Proof of high school graduation or GED certification
- A minimum of two years of significant full-time work experience beyond high school
- Submission of all required items for the admission process

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate with an associate degree from the Division of Adult and Professional Studies at Indiana Wesleyan University, the following requirements must be met:

- Completion of the 62 credit hour core
- Earn a Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- A minimum of "C" (2.0) must be achieved in both of the required communications courses (ENG 140 and ENG 141). Failure to achieve a "C" in either course will require repeating the course until a "C" is achieved before the student may continue with the core
- Payment of all tuition and fees

## TUITION AND FEES (Effective July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008)

### ■ Initial Deposit - \$100

After all application materials have been submitted and evaluated, an applicant will receive notification advising of his/her acceptance status. Upon acceptance into the program, an initial deposit of \$100 must be submitted to reserve a space in a class. The deposit must be submitted two weeks prior to date of the first class or immediately after acceptance if there are less than two weeks before the first class.

### ■ Total Cost

The total cost of the program is divided into several payments spread over the course of the program. The first tuition payment is due 14 days prior to the first class. All subsequent tuition payments are due 3 weeks before the start date of each course. The exact amount of each payment varies based on the number of credit hours, fees, and the cost of books for the courses covered by the payment. For specific payment amounts and due dates, refer to a class tuition payment schedule.

- Tuition, books, and fees are fixed for students based upon the charges in effect upon enrollment in the core program unless the student withdraws, or changes any preset registration. In such instances the prevailing charges at the time of re-entry may apply.
- Books are not returnable for a refund.
- A \$50 charge will be assessed for any payment not received by the due date.
- A \$15 charge will be assessed for each check returned for non-sufficient funds.
- Initial deposit and payments may be made by check or telephone using VISA, MasterCard, or Discover, 800-621-8667 x2878 or 765-677-2878.
- Additional shipping costs may apply to books shipped to Alaska, Hawaii, or international destinations. Students in these locations are charged the actual shipping cost differential in addition to the amount shown above.
