

MASTER OF SCIENCE MANAGEMENT ONLINE

The Master of Science degree with a major in Management is a 36-hour graduate program designed to develop and advance the personal and technical management skills of working professionals. It is envisioned that successful graduates should be able to enhance their positions in both the profit or non-profit sectors.

This is a career-oriented degree program with emphasis on knowledge and skill in working with and leading people in an organizational environment. The program revolves around the ideal of servant leadership present in both quality management literature and the Christian tradition. Strategy, decision-making, quality, and the dynamics of change in organizations are all explored in the curriculum.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the Master of Science in Management Program:

- A baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
- An overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 in previous college work.
- A minimum of two (2) years of significant full-time work experience.
- Submission of all required items for the admissions process.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of all credits required in the curriculum sequence with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and a minimum grade of "C" in each course.
- Payment of all tuition and fees.
- Successful completion of an Applied Management Project that meets the specifications and requirements of Indiana Wesleyan University.

TRANSFER CREDITS

Indiana Wesleyan University may accept up to six (6) semester credit hours for transfer into the M.S. Management program. Credits must be earned from a regionally accredited institution.

TUITION AND FEES (Effective July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008)

■ Initial Deposit - \$100

After all application materials have been submitted and evaluated, an applicant will receive notification advising of his/her acceptance status. Upon acceptance into the program, an initial deposit of \$100 must be submitted to reserve a space in a class. The deposit must be submitted two weeks prior to date of the first class or immediately after acceptance if there are less than two weeks before the first class.

■ Total Cost

The total cost of the program is divided into several payments spread over the course of the program. The first tuition payment is due 14 days prior to the first class. All subsequent tuition payments are due 3 weeks before the start date of each course. The exact amount of each payment varies based on the number of credit hours, fees, and the cost of books for the courses covered by the payment. For specific payment amounts and due dates, refer to a class tuition payment schedule.

- Tuition, books, and fees are fixed for students based upon the charges in effect upon enrollment in the core program unless the student withdraws, or changes any preset registration. In such instances the prevailing charges at the time of re-entry may apply.
- Books are not returnable for a refund.
- A \$50 charge will be assessed for any payment not received by the due date.
- A \$15 charge will be assessed for each check returned for non-sufficient funds.

- Additional shipping costs may apply to books shipped to Alaska, Hawaii, or international destinations. Students in these locations are charged the actual Shipping cost differential in addition to the amount shown above.
